## ORDER

The Forensic Sciences Department receives various kinds of cases/exhibits for analysis/examination from various agencies and those agencies, except the (i) Tamil Nadu Police Department, (ii) Tamil Nadu Prohibition and Excise Department,

(iii) Tamil Nadu Vigilance and Anti-Corruption Department, (iv) Government Medical and Veterinary Institutions of Tamil Nadu, (v) Government Hospitals of Tamil Nadu, (vi) Criminal Courts in the State of Tamil Nadu, (vii) High Court of Madras, are required to pay the requisite Analysis Fee to the Forensic Sciences Department. The Offices/Agencies, which have been classified for the fee regulation are detailed below:-

2. In the Government order/letter sixth, seventh and eighth read above, while issuing the Rules regulating the payment of fees for the services rendered by the Forensic Sciences Department, orders were issued for revision of analysis fee for the following categories of cases/exhibit received for analysis/examination:-

- 3. In the Government order ninth read above, analysis fee on excise samples was revised. In the Government order tenth read above, the analysis fee on excise samples received from Lithographic Picture Varnish Manufacturers (denatured Spirit Licence-2 Licencesses) and Spirituous Medicinal Preparation Companies was revised.
- 4. The Director (i/c), Forensic Sciences Department, Chennai, has sent a proposal to Government for the revision of analysis fee charged on the samples received in various Analytical Divisions of the Tamil Nadu Forensic Sciences Department. In addition to the proposed revision of analysis fee, the Director (i/c) has also proposed to incorporate certain Offices/Agencies as Category-I and Category-II, under Class-F in the rules regulating the analysis fee, for whom the analysis fee on excise samples was revised in the Government orders ninth and tenth read above.
- 5. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director (i/c), Forensic Sciences Department, carefully. It is found that the categories of cases/exhibit received for analysis/examination, hitherto classified under 6 broad categories, has now been simplified and re-classified into 5 broad categories, as detailed below:-

The Director (i/c) has stated that, if the proposed fee is ordered by the Government, the expected revenue receipt (excluding the revenue earned through analysis of excise samples) generated would be about three times the revenue received currently towards analysis fee.

6. The Government have, therefore, decided to accept the proposal of the Director (i/c), Forensic Sciences Department, subject to certain modifications in the levy of analysis fee for the cases relating to "DNA Profiling (Other than paternity cases)". Accordingly, the Government direct that the analysis fee, levied in the Government order/letter sixth, seventh and eighth read above, be revised as detailed below:-

## Annexure

# State Rules to regulate the payment of analysis fee for examination of various cases/exhibits/articles in the Tamil Nadu Forensic Sciences Department

- 1. Short Title:- These rules will be called as "State Rules to regulate the payment of analysis fee for examination of various cases/exhibits/articles in the Tamil Nadu Forensic Sciences Department.
- 2. Address for sending samples for examination of cases:-Applications should be sent to the Director, Forensic Sciences Department, 30-A, Kamarajar Salai, Mylapore, Chennai 600 004.
- 3. Departments/Offices, which are classified as "Class-A", shall be exempted from payment of fee for examination of cases, i.e., Applications received from the Police/Vigilance & Anticorruption Departments of Government of Tamil Nadu, either directly or through Courts or through Government Medical/ Veterinary Institutions in Tamil Nadu (including authorized private Medico-legal autopsy centres) and Clinical Toxicology cases from Government Medical/Veterinary Institutions in Tamil Nadu.
- 4. Departments/Offices, which are classified as "Class-B", "Class-C", "Class-D", "Class-E" and "Class-F", as detailed below, shall pay fee for examination of cases, as specified in Schedules I, II and III to these rules:-
- (i) "Class-B":-Applications received from other Departments, Local Bodies, Universities, etc., under the Government of Tamil Nadu and cases from the Family Courts/Other Courts of Law in the State of Tamil Nadu wherein the Government of Tamil Nadu is not a party.
- (ii) "Class-C":-Applications received from Courts of Law and Departments of other State Governments including their Local Bodies, Universities etc., and cases from other States, referred by any authority in Tamil Nadu.
- (iii) "Class-D":-Applications received from Public Sector Undertakings, Boards, Commissions, Tribunals, Councils, etc., of the State of Tamil Nadu/Other States/Union Territory/Central Government and Departments of Union Territory/Central Government.
- (iv) "Class-E":-Applications received from Banks including Nationalised Banks, Private Hospitals/Colleges and others.

- (v) "Class-F":-The following Departments/Offices in the State of Tamil Nadu shall pay fee for examination of Excise samples etc.:-
- (a) Category-I:-Applications received from Officers under the control of Commissioner of Prohibition and Excise of Government of Tamil Nadu, viz., Excise Supervisory Officers of Blending Units and Breweries, Assistant Commissioner of Excise and Bonded Manufactory Officers, Managers/Assistant Manager of TASMAC and Denaturant Licensees, etc.
- (b) Category—II:-Applications received from (i) Lithographic Picture Varnish Manufacturers (Denatured Spirit Licence-2 Licensees), who are manufacturing picture varnish for lithographic purposes; and (ii) Spirituous Medicinal Preparation Companies, who are manufacturing medicinal preparations containing alcohol, referred through the Bonded Manufactory Officers, Assistant Commissioners and other officers concerned, who are posted by the Commissioner of Prohibition and Excise, for verification of percentage of alcohol in the medicinal preparation
- Note: Applications from classes not categorized above will be accepted under special circumstances, if they are not detrimental to normal work and as per the discretion of the Director, Forensic Sciences Department, Chennai-600 004.
- 5. (i) Levy of analysis fee:-The classes of user-agencies referred under rule 4 (i) to (iv) above, except "Class-F" and the quantum of fees chargeable towards examination of samples received in various Divisions shall be regulated as per the "Table" in the "Schedule-I" appended to this rule.
- (ii) The user-agencies classified under "Class-F", referred under rule 4 (v) (a) above and the quantum of fees chargeable towards examination of excise samples received in Excise Division shall be regulated as per the "Table" in the "Schedule-II" appended to this rule.
- (iii) The user-agencies classified under "Class-F", referred under rule 4 (v) (b) above and the quantum of fees chargeable towards examination of excise samples received in Excise Division shall be regulated as per the "Table" in the "Schedule-III" appended to this rule.
- (iv) Waiver of analysis fee in certain cases:-The fees may be waived for the services mentioned in Serial No.4 (i) of the Schedule-I, viz., "DNA

Profiling-Paternity cases", in respect of the cases referred by Family Courts in the State of Tamil Nadu, wherein the annual income of the complainant/plaintiff

Profiling-Paternity cases", in respect of the cases referred by Family Courts in the State of Tamil Nadu, wherein the annual income of the complainant/plaintiff is Rs.24,000/- (Rupees twenty four thousand only) or below (as authenticated by the competent revenue authority and attested by the judge of the Family Court).

- (v) The analysis fees mentioned in the said "Schedule-I", "Schedule-II" and "Schedule-III" do not cover travelling allowance with regard to cases falling under "Classes-B to F" and it shall be governed by rule 11 below.
- 6. (i) Mode of payment of analysis fee:-Among cases falling under "Class-B", the Departments which require the services of the Director, Forensic Sciences Department, Chennai-4, may make payment by Demand Draft (or) by book adjustment and present the adjustment challan for the purpose of record.
- (ii) Head of account for payment of analysis fees:- In cases referred from Courts of Law under Class-B and in all cases falling under Class-C, Class-D, Class-E and Class-F, the fee is payable in advance and each application should be accompanied by a treasury challan showing the payment of the amount under head of account, "0055.00.Police 800.Other Receipts AK.Receipts from Forensic Science Department 27.Non-Taxation Fees 99.0thers" (D.P. Code:0055-00-800-AK-27-99").
- (iii) Payment of fee may also be made by Demand Draft drawn in favour of "Director, Forensic Sciences Department, Chennai-4".
  - (iv) Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- 7. Instructions regarding payment of fee:-In all cases falling under Classes-B to F, the authorities submitting the cases will be informed of the exact cost involved in the analysis/examination and they will given instructions for further steps to be taken to pay the fees.
- 8. Additional fee for deposition in Court of Law:-In all cases falling under Classes-B to F, if the Scientist of the Forensic Sciences Department is requires more than one day for deposing evidence before a Court of Law, Commission, etc., an additional fee of Rs.3000/- (Rupees three thousand only) will be charged, in addition to the Travelling Allowance and Daily Allowances, for each day after the first day on which the evidence is given.
- 9. Instruction to the Forensic Scientists for deposition before Court of Law:-In all cases falling under Classes-B to F, the Scientists of the Forensic Sciences Department will be prepared to attend Court of Law, etc. Provided that

they can do so without detriment to their normal work and they are requisitioned at least one month ahead of the hearing date.

- 10. Instruction to the Investigation Authorities regarding deposition by the Forensic Scientist:-Presiding Officers of the Courts of Law and the Inquiring Authorities are requested to detain the Scientists of the Forensic Sciences Department, for the least possible time compatible with the requirement of the cases. They are also requested to accept, as far as possible, the time and date for attendance offered by these scientists, as they have to frequently attend several Courts in the course of their official duties in addition to their regular laboratory work.
- 11. Payment of Travelling Allowance to the Forensic Scientists and Office Assistants who attend the Courts for deposition:-When the Scientists of the Forensic Sciences Department are required to travel in order to give evidence or for any similar purpose, the authority employing their services in cases falling under Classes-B to F will be required to pay travelling allowances and daily allowance at the rates laid down under the Tamil Nadu Travelling Allowances Rules, 2005, as amended from time to time. Such allowances will also be payable for the Office Assistant accompanying the Scientists at the rate fixed by the Government of Tamil Nadu. In such cases, the Presiding Officers of the Courts and Inquiring Authorities concerned will be required to certify that the cost of such allowance has been deposited in the Court and it will be paid to the Scientists concerned after the deposition of evidence is over. In the event of receipt of Travelling Allowance from the Court, the Forensic Scientist shall not claim the Travelling Allowance in his office.
